

# Sabbath Rest

## ECFA

As of December 22, 2013, Shepherd's Refuge is an Accredited Member of the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability. For those not familiar with the ECFA, here are two paragraphs from its president's editorial found in the "Enhancing Trust 2013" publication:

*"Thirty-four years ago, the ECFA founders determined that a set of high governance, financial, and fundraising/stewardship standards would serve the Christ-centered community well. The fundamental concept was pass/fail—ECFA's members must pass all of the standards, all of the time. Noncompliance with even one of the standards disqualified an organization from ECFA membership. Time has confirmed the wisdom of those early decisions.*

*This is the day for Christ-centered organizations to step up in terms of accountability, transparency, and integrity. Accreditation by ECFA communicates credibility to givers. This increased giver confidence leads to greater generosity of time, treasure and talents, which, in turn, provides enhanced funding to fulfill the Great Commission!"*

The founding history came out of the late 1970s, when there was growing public and political concern over an increase of questionable fundraising practices in the non-profit sector. Additionally, donors and governmental agencies expressed concern over the management of their donations to achieve publicly state objectives as presented in fundraising appeals. Donors had no source for an objective assessment of the financial integrity of Christian organizations desiring their support.

Senator Mark Hatfield challenged key Christian leaders to police their own charities or face the potential of governmental intervention. This led to the formation of ECFA. Standards were established and a chartering process was initiated for applicant ministries.

A new record was set with 49 couples and 8 individuals being served resulting in a total of 429 guest / nights. (2 guests staying 1 night equals 2 guest/nights)

Not to be outdone, donations matched the increase in operating expenditures. We praise the Lord for all who became new partners, and for all those who faithfully continued their support throughout the year.


## Outlook 2014


